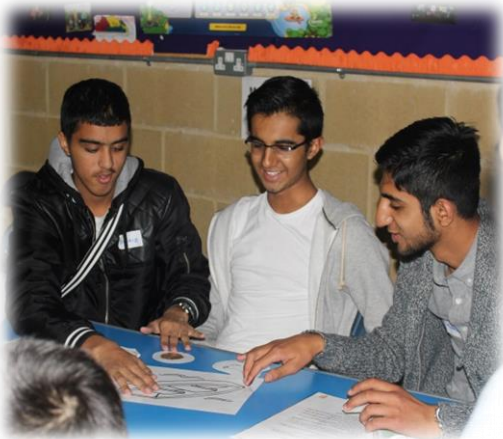


Off to a Flying Start!

Schools Enjoying the Programme

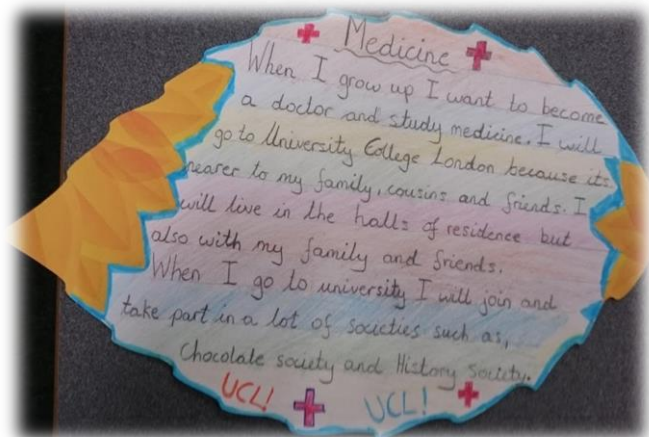
